Recycled plastics including recycled fridges and added to biobased plastics to make this lovely collection. TIME gravel bike – ADHX (Alpe d'Huez X)



OK, so maybe this is just me dreaming a little too big, but can you blame me? The frame of this bike is made from a braided carbon structure using biobased Dyneema®, a fiber 15 x stronger than steel and light enough to float on water. And you will save the planet because it is so beautiful that you'll ride rather than drive for any journey (and because you had to sell the car to afford it).

Well, Chanel's range of beauty products has benefits that are more than skin deep, with over 97% of ingredients being from natural origin and packaging made biobased materials including a lid from Sulapac, a proprietary material, from residues of wood (FSC) and Camelia seed shells. You could say that this product combines technology, style and beauty care in one pot.

An-Du Back to basics shampoo bar



This back to basics shampoo bar uses sophorolipids – biologically grown surfactants (soaps) made by fermentation using a yeast found around honey and bees. These sophorolipids are produced on a small scale by nature and are now being made at larger scale to replace the fossil based ingredients in cleaning products. Because they come from natural yeasts these products are biodegradable and are more gentle on skin than traditional soaps.
